

Tennis Courts Court Rules and Regulations

- All AE residents are members. Contact Scott Bridgeman for a key.
- Guests must be accompanied by an AE resident or member.
- Playtime is limited to maximum of sixty (60) consecutive minutes when others are waiting to play.
- Courts close at 11:00 pm.
- All USTA matches are posted on <http://ashborougheast.org/aeha/calendar/>
- Players (16 and over) have priority from 6pm on weekdays. Children may play on courts after 6pm on weekdays, only if the courts are not being used.
- Ben Hough, AE pro has reserved courts for practices and lessons.
- If you lose your key, a replacement can be acquired for a fee of \$5.

Court Maintenance

- No use of courts when wet or slick.
- Only smooth soled tennis shoes are allowed on the courts.
- Courts are for tennis only. No skateboards, bikes, roller blades, scooters, electronic vehicles, non-tennis balls, or remote controlled cars on the court.
- Please remove trash from the area, turn off lights, and lock the gate upon leaving.

Courtesy

- Players should conduct themselves as ladies and gentlemen and observe court etiquette.
- Parents are responsible for supervision of children in and around the court areas.
- Shirts must be worn while at the courts.
