

Ashborough East Pool Rules and Information

For the safety and enjoyment of all our Ashborough East neighbors we ask that all residents and their guests follow the rules and guidelines for use of our community pool. Thank you.

- The pool and pavilion are open to all AE residents current on their HOA dues and fines paid. Access is by use of key FOB. If you don't have a FOB or your FOB is not working, contact our property management company, ROG Coastal (laurenhardy@rogcoastal.com, 843-647-7722).
- There is no lifeguard on duty. Swim at your own risk. There is no diving in the shallow end of the pool.
- The pool season runs from mid-April through mid-October. Hours of operation are the summer daylight hours of 6:30am to 8pm. When daylight hours shorten and sunset occurs earlier, the pool will close at 7pm. Night swimming is prohibited. Dates and hours can be changed at the discretion of the HOA Board.
- The pool area is under 24-hour video surveillance.
- No alcohol, smoking, vaping, tobacco products, gum, glass containers, bicycles, skateboards, roller blades, firearms or weapons are allowed in the pool compound. No food or drinks are allowed in the water.
- Service animals are allowed on the pool deck but are not allowed in the water.
- Swimming is prohibited during thunderstorms. As soon as thunder is heard everyone must vacate the pool. The pool will remain closed until 20 minutes after the last clap of thunder has been heard.
- Swimming is prohibited during severe rainstorms. If during a rainstorm the bottom of the pool cannot be seen all swimmers must vacate the pool until visibility is restored.
- Children 14 years and younger must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (18 years or older). The kiddie pool is for ages five and under.
- No running, horse play, profanity, disrespect, or vandalism is allowed or FOB will be deactivated.
- The pool is a family-friendly environment. It would be appreciated if music selections and pool attire reflect that.
- Persons of any age who lack control of urination and/or defecation are required to wear swim diapers when in the pool.
- There is a maximum of four guests per household. Residents must stay in the pool area with their guests at all times. The fee for more than four guests per household is \$2.00 per each additional guest. Payment must be by check made out to AEHA and may be turned into the pool committee chair (Marissa Knight) or a board member.
- Floatation devices and small rafts are allowed when the pool is not too crowded.
- We have one lane for laps. Please keep clear of the lane when it is in use.
- The pavilion may be rented for parties, not to exceed 25 people. Rental is first come, first served, and secured by a deposit. Contact Tiffany Pecoraro at tpecoraro1401@gmail.com or 504-232-1401 for availability and reservations.
- All trash must be disposed of in the trash and recycling bins near the pool office.
- Please close umbrellas when you leave the pool.
- AEHA is not responsible for lost or stolen items. There is a Lost & Found bin outside the pool office.
- EMERGENCY PHONE MOUNTED ON WALL TO LEFT OF OFFICE DOOR CONNECTS DIRECTLY TO 911.
